The Sulgrave Pocket Park Action Group is very pleased to announce that Big Lottery Funding has been secured to refurbish the Sulgrave Pocket Park play equipment and pond area.

It is our intention to make the park a safer, more enjoyable space for all Sulgrave residents and visitors and the grant of £49,999 will certainly help to make this possible.

#### But we still need more help.

In order to save money by carrying out clearance work at the park ourselves, we are planning a Working Party on the weekend of 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> February from 10 am to 3 pm and we would like to invite all Sulgrave residents, friends and relations to join us to start to clear the site.

We plan to meet at the park around 10am for a Health and Safety briefing and then get to work on preparing the site and removing debris, levelling off the ground in places. We will also require help in removing debris from the site.
