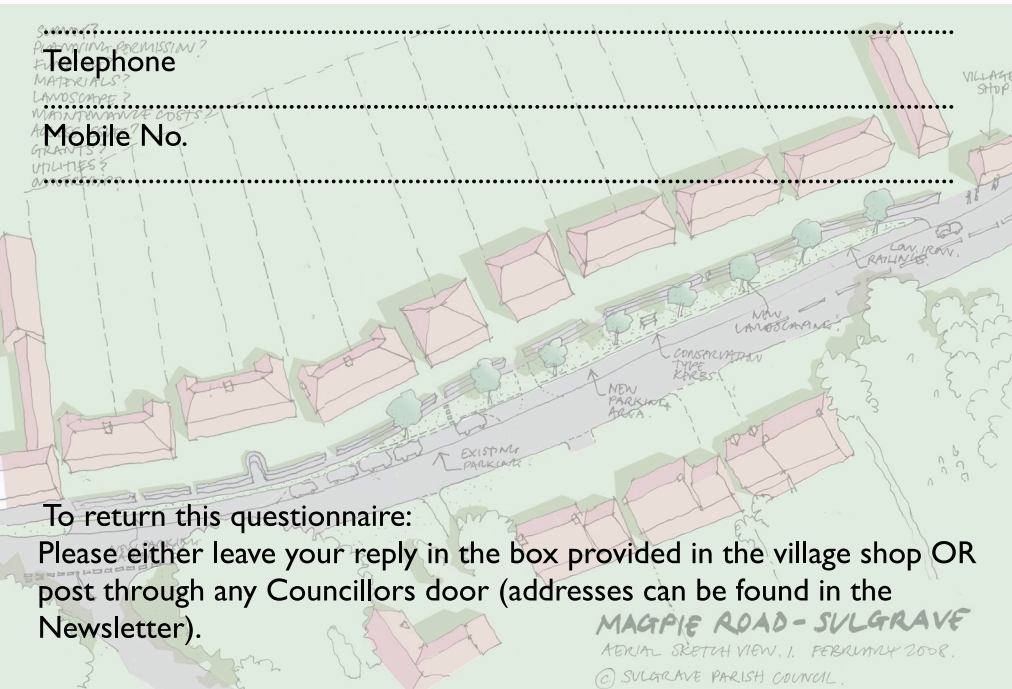

Sulgrave Parish Council is aware that residents of Magpie Road experience difficulty in finding sufficient space for parking and that the grass verge on the north side of the road is often used for this purpose. As a consequence the area is often muddy and unsightly despite being in the heart of the conservation area and at the entrance to the village. The land is owned by Northamptonshire County Council but is maintained by Sulgrave Parish Council. The Parish Council is therefore seeking the views of residents about the possibility of improving the area.
