Another positive performance for the Shop so a big thank you to everyone for your support! Our sales for the last 3 months (August to October) have shown an increase in sales of 5% which is 2.7% higher overall than for the first 10 months of 2010. October was a fantastic month with a 6.6% up on the same month in 2010. These results compare exceptionally well to the current general retail environment & we hope reflects the

benefits that we are all enjoying from having such a fantastic, local facility available within Sulgrave. When you add in the benefit of having the Post Office services available to us, then we really do have something to be proud of within our community.

We are now also well underway with the phased redecoration of our Shop & apologise if you have been inconvenienced by the Monday morning stock replacement closures! A couple more Sunday afternoon sessions should see us finished well ahead of the run up to Christmas.
