Sadly I have been unable to get any more – but, I have managed to track down a small parcel of a high quality, medal-winning Valpolicella Ripasso which is made from the same grapes and shares the intense, full-bodied characteristics of the Appassimento. At £8.45 it is a little more expensive than most of the wines in our range but, as the RRP is almost £14 a bottle, it is a real bargain and a wine that you could take to a dinner party without embarrassment.

Word has got out that the shop is a finalist in the Countryside Alliance Awards and we have just received a letter of congratulation from our MP, Andrea Leadsom, (on House of Commons notepaper no less) in which she wishes us good luck in the finals. Winners to be announced next month.
