19/31. <u>To receive apologies for absence</u> There were no apologies.

19/32.To receive Declarations of InterestCllr Priestman declared an interest in the tree application at The Limes, 2 Manor Road.

19/33a. <u>To approve and sign the minutes of the meeting held on 7th February 2019</u> The minutes of the last meeting were approved and signed as a true record of the meeting.

19/33b. Matters Arising

Bus Shelter - The Chair and Cllr Higginson have looked at the condition of the bus shelter. Quotations were previously received to make it last longer. Another competitive quote has been received to replace the cladding and there is a lot of rot/woodworm. The quote will involve an intensive anti worming process. The character of the existing shelter will be retained. To be discussed at the April meeting.

Fees/Purchase of Castle Mound – Following the last meeting the letter was sent to the solicitors and the matter has now been resolved. A final figure of £5613.60 was paid.

Bus Services – Discussions are ongoing. A local meeting is being held in Culworth on 13th March. The Chair is unable to attend but will ask for feedback.

Footpaths – These will be trimmed back before the grass cutting season starts.

19/34. <u>To receive an update on HS2 and renovations to the Church Hall</u>

There was little to report on HS2.

The letter from Lucy Apperly was circulated. It was agreed the Parish Council will remain neutral and focus on local issues that arise.

Action: The Chair to respond to the letter.

Cllr Daniels confirmed the New Homes Bonus funding cannot be used to secure the lease on the Church Hall. It can be used to pay for renovation items and the next deadline for applications is 31 st May 2019.

Action: Cllr Daniels to make contact with Ingram Lloyd.

19/35. <u>To discuss the repair of the wall in Church Street and overhanging trees</u>

Repair work will be needed to the wall in Church Street. This was paid for before by the Parish Council. The trees will require trimming. It was agreed the committee could get quotes for the wall repair and tree work. They will examine the wall in a few weeks time.
