#### 21/85. To receive apologies for absence

#### 21/86. To receive Declarations of Interest

### 21/87a. To approve and sign the minutes of the meeting held on 10th June 2021

## 21/87b. Matters Arising

Cllr Resignation Letter – This was received from Anna Faure.

Pocket Park – The work to the youth shelter still needs to be done. The felt has been purchased.

Village Library – The cases have been made and castors put on. They have been half filled with good quality books. It was agreed that someone purchasing a book can make a donation. Councillors to think of ideas of how to spend the donations. The official opening date is 11<sup>th</sup> September 2021 at 10.30am. The PCC will put on coffee and cakes.

Broken light on Magpie Road – The Parish Clerk has chased EON for a response. EON are awaiting a response from DW Windsor.

#### 21/88. To receive an update on HS2

The road to Marston St Lawrence will be closed week commencing 5<sup>th</sup> July which will mean more traffic using Sulgrave. Information has been received on footpath closures.

# 21/89. <u>To receive an update from Sulgrave Manor</u>

A family fun day is taking place on 4<sup>th</sup> July. A full programme of events to November is in the latest newsletter. Residents are able to get their own passes but have to prove residency.

#### 21/90. To receive an update on the allotments

There has been a change of committee, a new Chairman and Treasurer. The committee would like to put up a 3 rail fence with a 3 foot gate in the centre. It would tidy the area up and keep it open. They are going to get quotes.

#### 21/91. To receive an update on improvement work to the Village/Church Hall

The stage has been removed and the curtains sold. Work should be completed by mid August.

#### 21/92. To receive an update on the flagpole

A very detailed response was received from Helmdon Parish Council. Residents near the proposed locations should be consulted. The approximate cost of the flagpole is between £600 and £800. A note will be put in the next newsletter. To be discussed at the next meeting.

#### 21/93. To discuss a replacement village sign at the Magpie Road end

Two sample village signs have been circulated, one designed by a resident. The sign on the Helmdon Road will be replaced at the same time. If the new sign is a similar size to the old one and the existing poles can be used, the Regulations team will issue a license. ICouncillors to let the Clerk know of their preferred choice.

Action: The Parish Clerk to forward the preferred choice to Northants Highways.

#### 21/94. To discuss the planting of wildflowers

The idea of planting wildflowers was discussed. There is a flat piece on Castle Mound. Councillors to think of other areas. Existing turf can be lifted.

Action: The Chair to speak to Mr Tims for further advice.
