Apologies for Absence

Cllr Will Priestman.

Elections

Cllr Richard Fonge elected Parish Council Chairman for the forthcoming year, with **Cllr Will Priestman** as Vice Chairman.

Richard, on his re election, thanked his fellow councillors for their support. He then announced the resignation of **CIIr Neil Higginson** for personal reasons and thanked him for the six years he had been on the Parish Council, with particular reference to the excellent job he had done in being responsible for the grass mowing contract.

High Speed Rail (HS2).

Clir Staples reported that Simon Davies, our local engagement officer, was leaving shortly and she would be liaising in future with his replacement.

The local HS2 contractors would be working longer hours, starting at 6.00 am, but there would be no Sunday work.

The B4525 would be closed sometime in the near future for the tunnel excavation. Further details to follow.

Flagpole.

The flagpole not being visible in its current churchyard location, it was agreed to apply to West Northants Council for planning permission to re-site it by the Bus Shelter, opposite the Village Shop.

Pocket Park.

Clir Staples to apply to HS2 for £5000 match funding for new equipment in Pocket Park. This was taking up an offer from the meeting between councillors and the HS2 senior engagement officer.
